TIER 2 ALLOWS INDOOR OPERATIONS TO RESUME FOR SOME **BUSINESSES INCLUDING:**

- Personal Care Services
- All Retail with max 50% capacity
- Restaurants with max 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer
- Gyms and Fitness Centers with max 10% capacity
- Museums, Zoos, and Aquariums with indoor activities with max 25% capacity
- 100 people, whichever is fewer

- Shopping Centers (Malls, Destination) Centers, Swap Meets) with:
 - Max 50% capacity
 - Closed common areas
 - Reduced capacity food courts (see restaurants)
- Hotels and Lodging with Fitness centers with 10% max capacity
- Movie Theaters with max 25% capacity or
 Places of Worship with max 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer
