### Open With Modifications and 100% Masking

- Critical Infrastructure
- Outdoor playgrounds
- Shopping centers at 20% Capacity
- Offices for critical infrastructure when remote work not possible
- Childcare, pre-k, schools
- Non-urgent medical and dental care
- Retail at 20% Capacity
- Grocery Stores at 35% Capacity
- Restaurants with Take-Out/Delivery Only
- Hotels and lodging for critical infrastructure support only
- Places of worship and political expression outdoors only
